



## Adult Student Financial Aid Fact Sheet

Notre Dame de Namur University offers a wide range of academic programs to adult students through three distinct divisions: Graduate, Credential, and Evening Bachelor's. A large percentage of the students enrolled in these divisions receive financial aid to make their higher education a reality. The goal of the Office of Financial Aid is to help you understand the opportunities open to you as an adult student. This fact sheet will give you a brief summary of the financial aid process, awards available and other financing options.

### How to receive a financial aid package from NDNU

1. Get admitted to NDNU: Apply to NDNU and submit your documents as soon as possible in order to receive a decision on your file
2. File the 2017–2018 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) **NDNU FAFSA Code: 001179**
3. An NDNU counselor will create and send to you a financial aid package, listing the awards for which you qualify
